What to Expect During Incident Response Engagement

	You've confirmed a single point of contact for coordination. Someone with authority and visibility needs to be available to approve actions, share info, and keep things moving.
	You've collected relevant leads or artifacts for investigation. Any logs, alerts, screenshots, suspicious emails, endpoint behavior, or user reports should be centralized and shared.
	You've defined the systems, accounts, and locations potentially involved. Even a rough scope helps prioritize analysis and limit spread. Include cloud accounts, devices remote users, and SaaS.
	You've paused all internal remediation until the forensic process begins. Do not wipe or reboot any systems until responders have been consulted, as preserving evidence is essential for analysis and maintaining a clear audit trail.
	You're ready to deploy tools or grant access for remote analysis. This may include forensic agents, log collection tools, or secure access credentials. Preparatio speeds engagement.
	You've identified critical systems and business operations. Knowing what's mission-critical helps prioritize recovery and focus efforts where downtime hurts most.
	You've confirmed communication channels. Use secure, out-of-band channels where possible. Avoid email if it's part of the compromise.
	You are aligned on reporting and executive briefings. Decide who needs regular updates and what schedule works best. Everyone, from IT to leadership, should be included appropriately.
